## Say No to the Asphalt Production Plant!

Vulcan Materials is seeking a special permit approval to be allowed to add an asphalt plant to their site off of Edsall Road, **nearby to your school or child care facility**. An asphalt plant could have a negative impact on you due to dangerous fumes and bad odors which may threaten children's health, and cause parents concern. According to the United States Government, the "health effects from exposure to asphalt fumes include headache, skin rash, sensitization, fatigue, reduced appetite, throat and eye irritation, cough, and skin cancer." The proposed site is surrounded by residences, businesses, schools, and child care facilities.

Right now, the Fairfax County Planning Commission and Board of Supervisors are poised to approve the Vulcan Materials proposal, including at least one and possibly multiple new asphalt facilities, as well as rezoning existing residential and commercial areas as "heavy industrial."
